



On average, two women a week are killed by a current or former partner.



Women, on average, are abused more than 30 times before they call police for help.



Police say they have dealt with more than 1.1 million women and 720,000 men as victims of some kind of domestic abuse in the past year.



143 women died from male violence last year.



It has been cited that one in three victims of domestic abuse in Britain is male.



Around 750,000 children grow up having witnessed domestic violence.



Reports of domestic violence went up by 25% after each England game at the 2010 World Cup.
