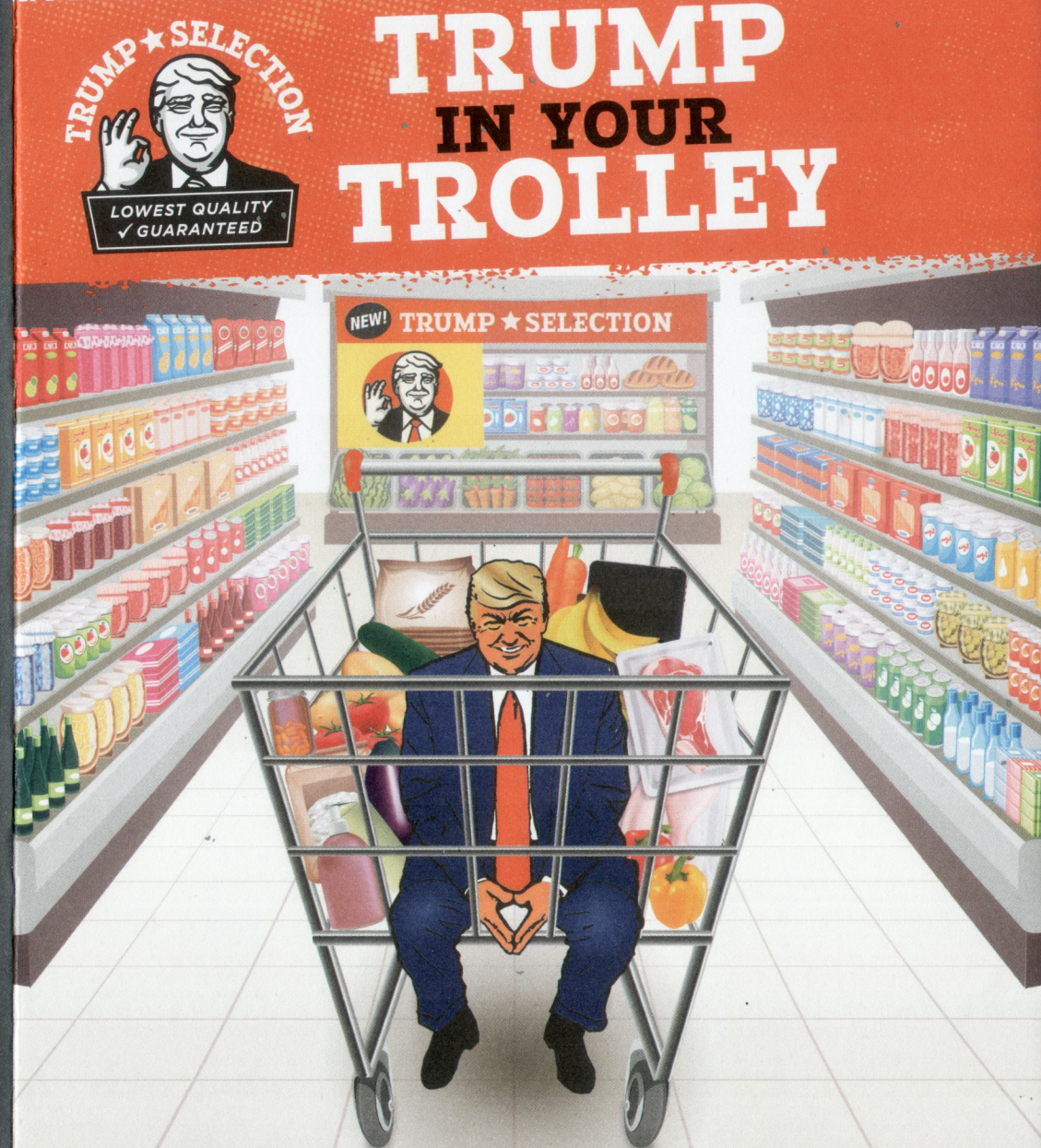

Food A US-UK trade deal would force the UK to tear up a whole range of regulations on pesticide, antibiotic and hormone use in farming. It would also open up the UK market to food produced using genetic engineering and chlorine washes for meat which is used to mask low animal welfare standards.

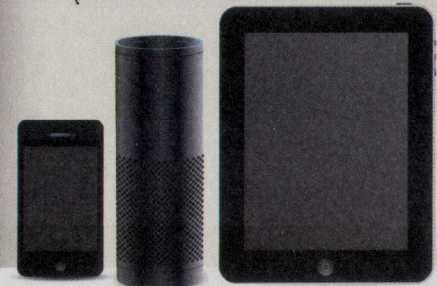
MEDICINES

Medicines The US is already attacking NICE, the body which assesses new medicines for the NHS and attempts to keep prices paid for by the public under control. Moreover, US firms want to be able to harvest NHS patient records, in order for them to develop medical tools and technologies to then sell back to the NHS at extortionate prices.

Cosmetics The EU currently bans the use of over 1,300 harmful substances for use in cosmetic products. The US bans just 11. A US-UK trade deal could lead to hundreds of dangerous substances approved for use in the UK.

Technology As a society we're beginning to understand the need to regulate the digital world and to think about how best to do so. But Big Tech wants to use the US-UK trade deal to keep the online world unregulated. The deal would concentrate even more power over our economy into the hands of a small number of US tech firms like Google, Amazon and Facebook.
